For all apprentices enrolled in the Apprentice Program on or before February 28, 2017, the percentage basis shall be as follows:

501 Hours – 1500 Hours	– 60% of the journeyman wage rate
1501 Hours – 2500 Hours	– 70% of the journeyman wage rate
2501 Hours – 3500 Hours	– 80% of the journeyman wage rate
3501 Hours – 4500 Hours	– 90% of the journeyman wage rate

For all apprentices enrolled in the Apprentice Program on or after March 1, 2017, the percentage basis shall be:

0 Hours – 1000 Hours	– 50% of the journeyman wage rate
1001 Hours – 2000 Hours	– 60% of the journeyman wage rate
2001 Hours – 3000 Hours	– 70% of the journeyman wage rate
3001 Hours – 4000 Hours	– 80% of the journeyman wage rate
4001 Hours – 5000 Hours	– 90% of the journeyman wage rate
